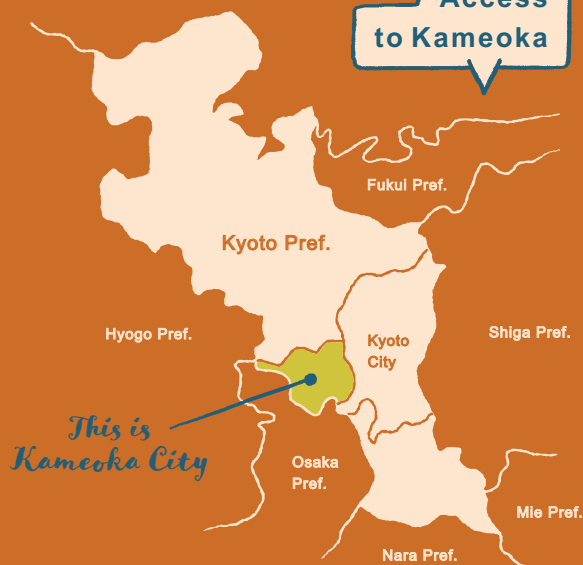

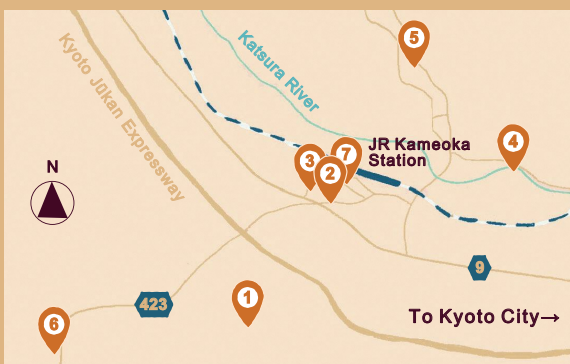

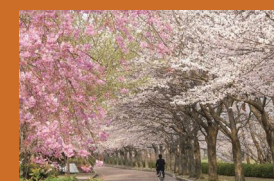
## What Kameoka is Like

Running for 3 straight days, the festival in Autumn is a special sight, especially the 11 traditional spears.



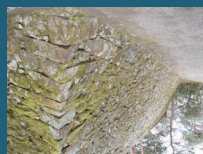
— Fog —

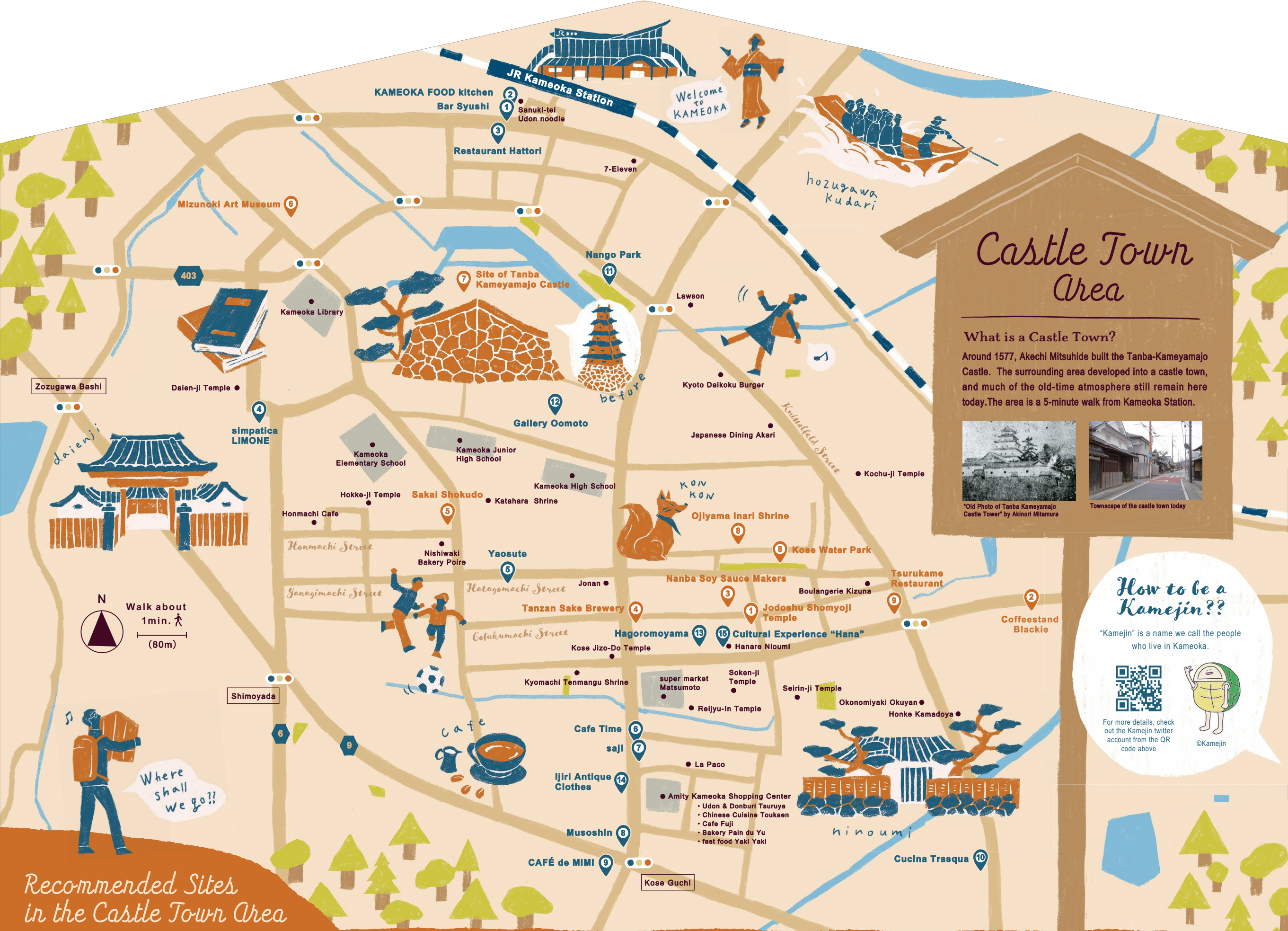

## Castle Town Area

### What is a Castle Town?

Around 1577, Akechi Mitsuhide built the Tanba-Kameyamajo Castle. The surrounding area developed into a castle town, and much of the old-time atmosphere still remain here today. The area is a 5-minute walk from Kameoka Station.

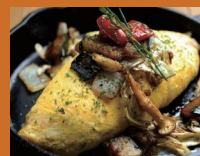

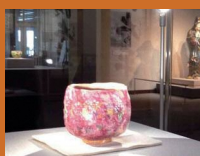
